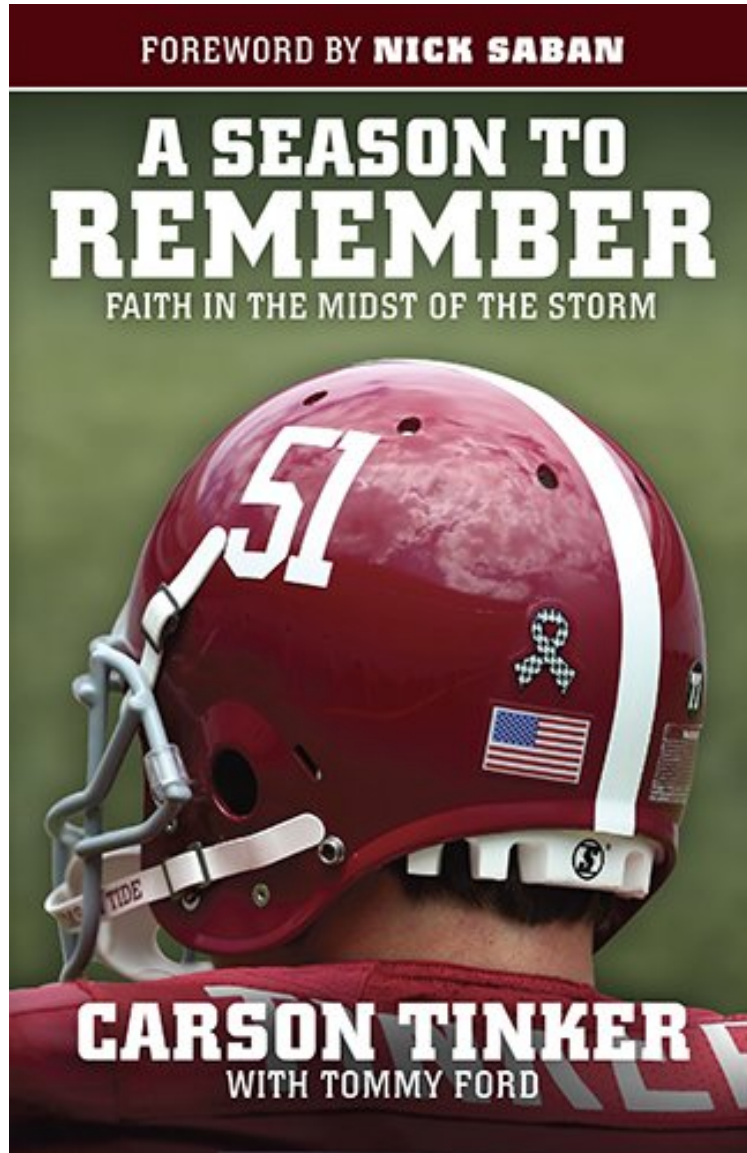

Carson's grandparents (Jim and Deanna Cartledge) have been close friends of my family for almost 30 years. The courage and trust in God's power and grace that Carson writes of is lived out every day by them. I will never forget the day of this tornado. My wife, son and I were in our basement, watching the tornado chew up Tuscaloosa on a local TV station. What we did not know at that time was that we were watching the tornado demolish Carson's house, hurling him across the street and killing his girlfriend.
