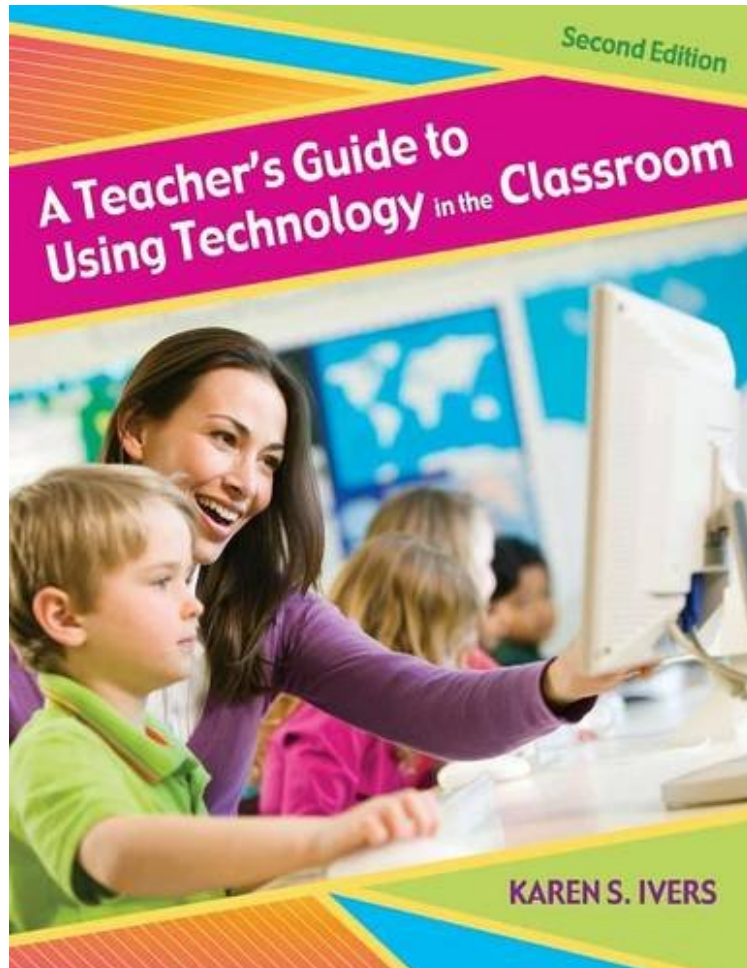

Karen Ivers does a great job of sorting and categorizing all the soundbites of what teachers go to during technology training so that they make sense. You can read parts of this book when needed, as chapters are not cumulative. You can also just skip to her helpful tables and charts that lay out what the technology is good for in terms of student and teacher applications, what it does, and where to find it. She offers examples and

explanations in the chapter if you want more information. I borrowed this book just to pull out the "good stuff" but am going to buy it for myself as a must-have resource. I'm a cheapo, but the amount of time and brain energy this book saves is well worth the \$30 or so. I have only one minor complaint, which is that I wish she had listed on her tables what was free versus what needed to be purchased and how much it cost.
