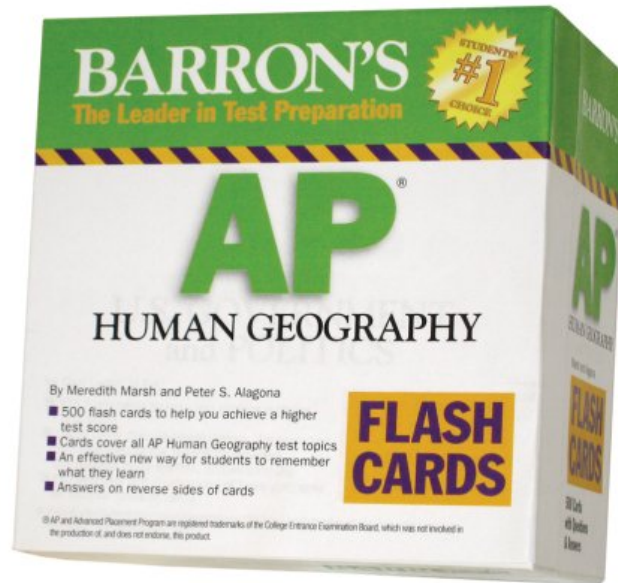

The only problem is that there's an extra amount of information on some of the flashcards, and that could be advantageous if you read this two weeks, but, when you're cramming everything in the night before the actual AP exam, it's kind of a handful. For example, you could have the simplest word like agriculture, the flashcards would give the most complicated definition with examples that can be pretty hard to grasp (well, when you're scanning it). There is a total of around 420+ flashcards, and most of them are relevant for the exam. I really do recommend getting this as it actually does help. In fact, if you have a hard time sticking your nose in a book, much like me, you NEED to get this since it's basically everything from the Barron's AP book. The flashcards personally helped me for this year's AP exam. I'm usually a last minute studier, so studying half the flashcards two days before the exam and the other half the night before helped me in memorizing important topics along with examples, which is GREAT for when writing the free responses. (I also recommend getting the Princeton AP Human Geo book, it's easy to read, if you actually open it, and has a more casual style to it as they would add funny titles, probably to ensure that you continue reading.) 5 of 5 people found the following review

This brand-new test preparation aid can be used alone or in tandem with Barrons new AP Human Geography manual. A set of 422 flash cards present frequently-asked questions on the AP exam with terms defined and concepts explained on the reverse side of each card. Questions cover all AP test topics. The cards measure 4 1/2" x 2 3/4" and have a punch-hole in one corner that accommodates an enclosed metal key-ring-style card holder. The ring allows students to arrange flash cards in any sequence that suits their study needs.
