He seeks not only knowledge of the crime, the "why and how" of a son he loved, but also the ability to forgive through the grace of God. The book is long on faith and short on evidence. Whitaker, after all, was to be a witness and was not allowed into the courtroom. We must take him at his word that he forgave his son for the crime, that he believes God chose the wife and the brother as instruments of His will to lure Bart, the older brother, back to a life in faith, and that he has gone on with his life in a positive way to share the virtues of having faith.
