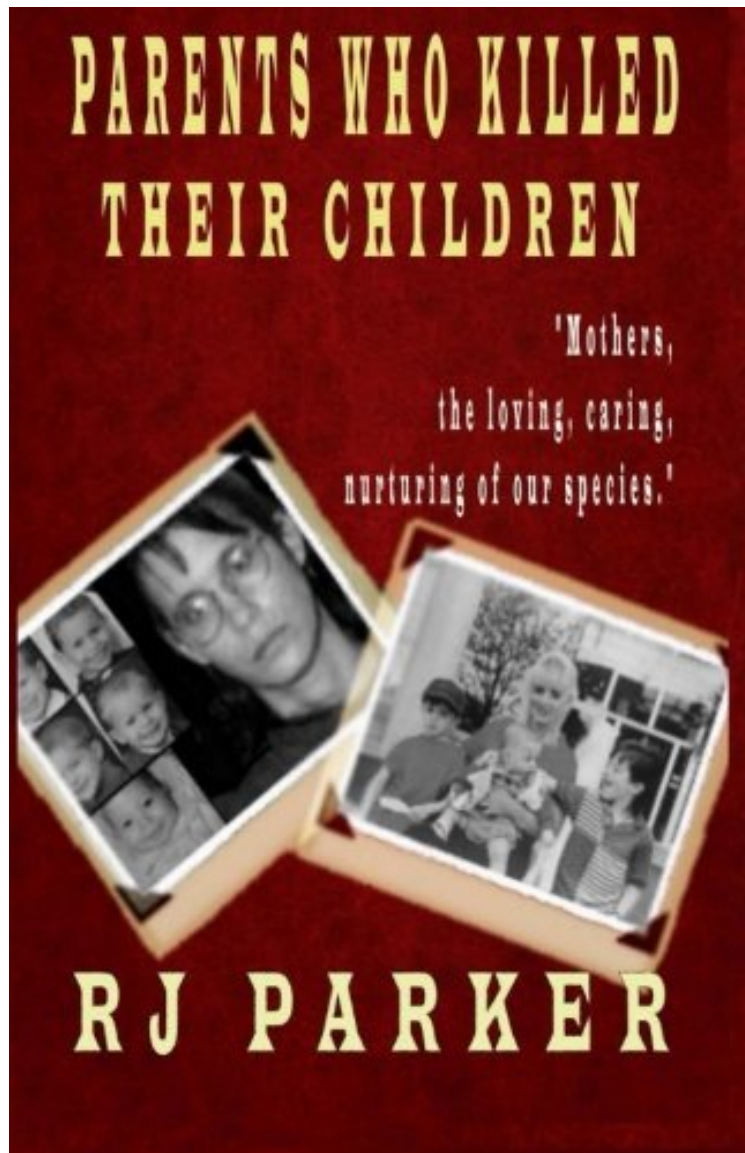

Parker manages to put the case and evidence before you, summarize the life and trial of the accused, detail the facts of the murder and tell a little about the victims. It's a highlight of the situation to, in my opinion, give the reader an idea of what is going on to determine which cases he would like to follow up on. In addition, he takes the time to raise questions that, as a society, we should all slow down and take a look at. It is not written in the typical "storytelling" mode, but rather like educational material. This is very good for early stage research. I do recommend.
