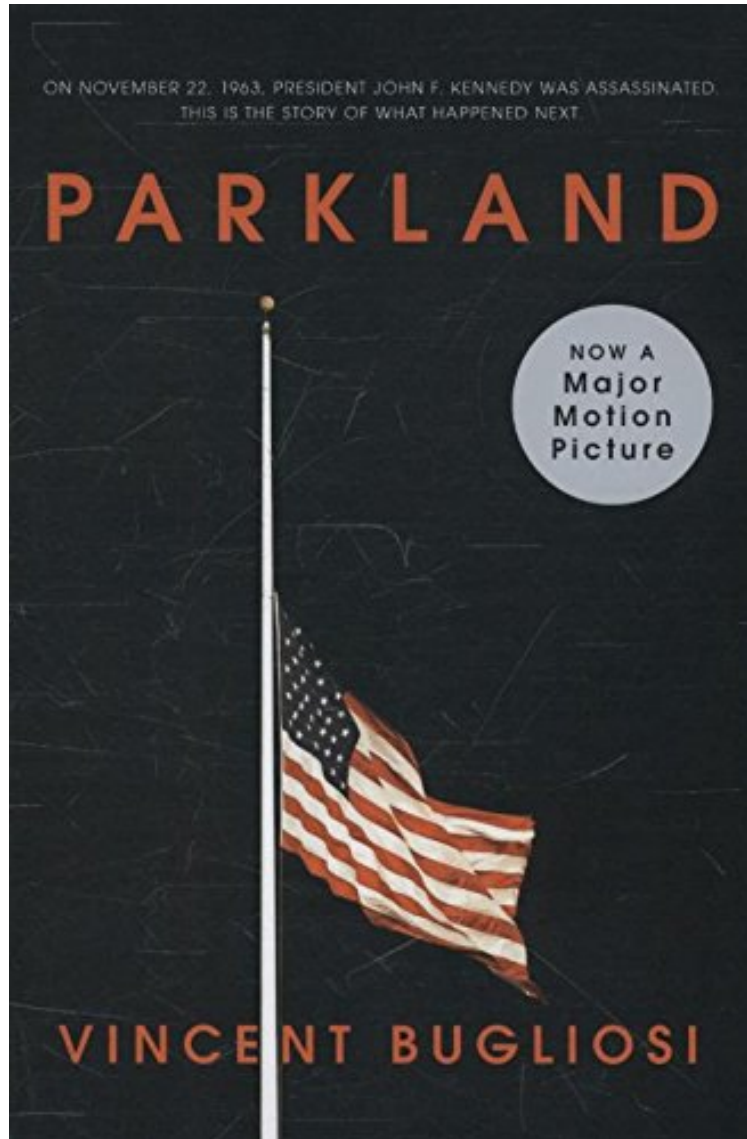

His attention to details, his critical analysis of those details, and his ability to present those facts in combination with his analysis in a readable and more logical presentation than the original incidents is without parity. His writing style, at first challenging, becomes superlative. The only drawback, and it is a miniscule one, is that the paperback version I purchased, although having thirty-four pages of annotated black-and white photos, seemed inadequate for a book as detailed and incredibly well-footnoted (1557 of them) as this one. The entire town was riveted by the events as we saw them on television. This book helped me relive those days and give more facts and information than I remembered.
