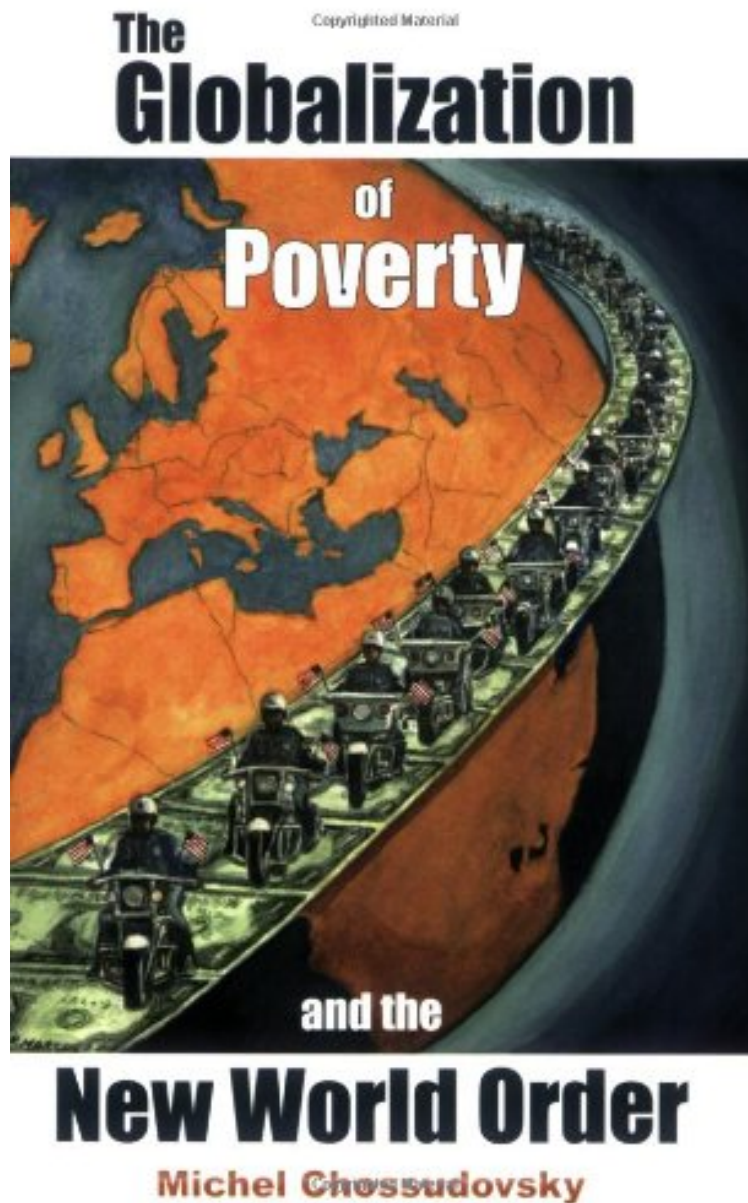

The environmental destruction is going to further exacerbate the famines now happening on an unprecedented scale and the industrialists and bankers and coupon clippers who now think they can hide away in their gated communities while sending their children off to private schools and vacationing in exclusive resorts with armed guards are going to find that the toxic world they have created is going to ultimately result in their demise as well.As the author demonstrates the world is rapidly becoming a two class society in every country with the super rich and the poor and a dwindling middle class.
