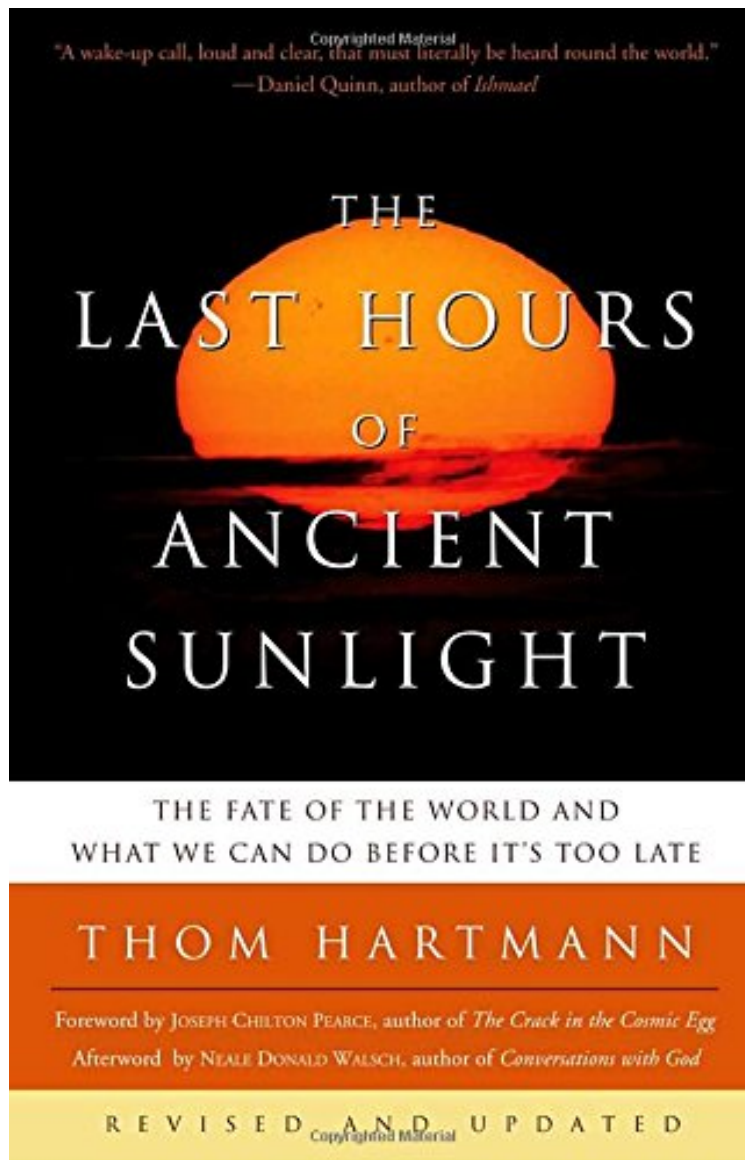

However, I was amazed at how concisely and eloquently Thom Hartmann managed to cover so much re the way humans have evolved through the thousands of years we have been here. As a student of anthropology I have to give Thom credit for packing so much easy to read and understand information into one relatively short book. If you have ever wondered how the world and it's people managed to get into the situation they are now in, this is probably one of the best books to read to help you understand, "What the heck happened?" This is not only an informative book, it is a practical book, in that it offers some solutions to many of the world's continuing problems. Although some might say that Thom is more optimistic than is warranted, considering the dimensions of the world's problems. And I certainly understand how some may say that, but I too share Thom's general optimism. The world is going thru 'a bad patch', (to put it mildly) and it can look a little dark dismal at times. Like Thom, I do think there is a multi-faceted, dare I use the word 'awakening' going on. More of a remembrance, than anything new. (Nothing is new under the sun.) But the remembrance will definitely lead to a better and saner world if a sufficient number of people begin to understand, as Einstein said, "The world we have made, as a result of the level of thinking we have done thus far, creates problems we cannot solve at the same level of thinking at which we created them."
